

LEGAL NOTICE FOR
FIRE DISTRICT
SPECIAL REFERENDUM

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a special Fire District Referendum in and for the Henrietta Fire District will take place on Tuesday, September 15, 2020, between the hours of 4:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. at the Henrietta Fire Station 6 located at 60 Erie Station Road, in the Town of Henrietta, New York, for the purpose of submitting the following described proposition for the approval of the qualified electors of said Fire District:

PROPOSITION

Shall the bond resolution adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Henrietta Fire District dated February 11, 2020, authorizing the construction and equipping of fire district buildings and facilities at Fire District Station #6, and various site and other incidental improvements, at a maximum estimated aggregate cost of \$8,428,688, authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Fire District and the issuance of notes in anticipation thereof; and pledging the faith and credit of the Fire District to the payment of such bonds and notes and the interest thereon, be approved?

The Board of Commissioners of the Henrietta Fire District, acting as lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), has completed its environmental review and, on February 11, 2020, has duly adopted a negative declaration with respect to the unlisted action and has determined that the implementation of the action as proposed will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.

A copy of the bond resolution referred to in the aforesaid proposition is on file in the office of the Secretary of said Fire District, where the same may be examined by any interested persons during regular business hours.

Those who are qualified to vote on the aforesaid proposition are qualified voters who shall have resided in said Fire District for thirty days next preceding such election.
